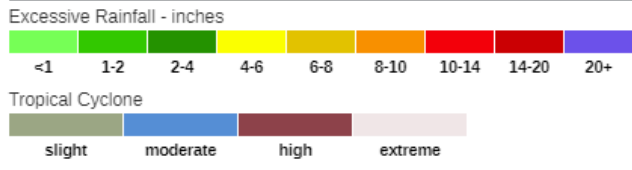
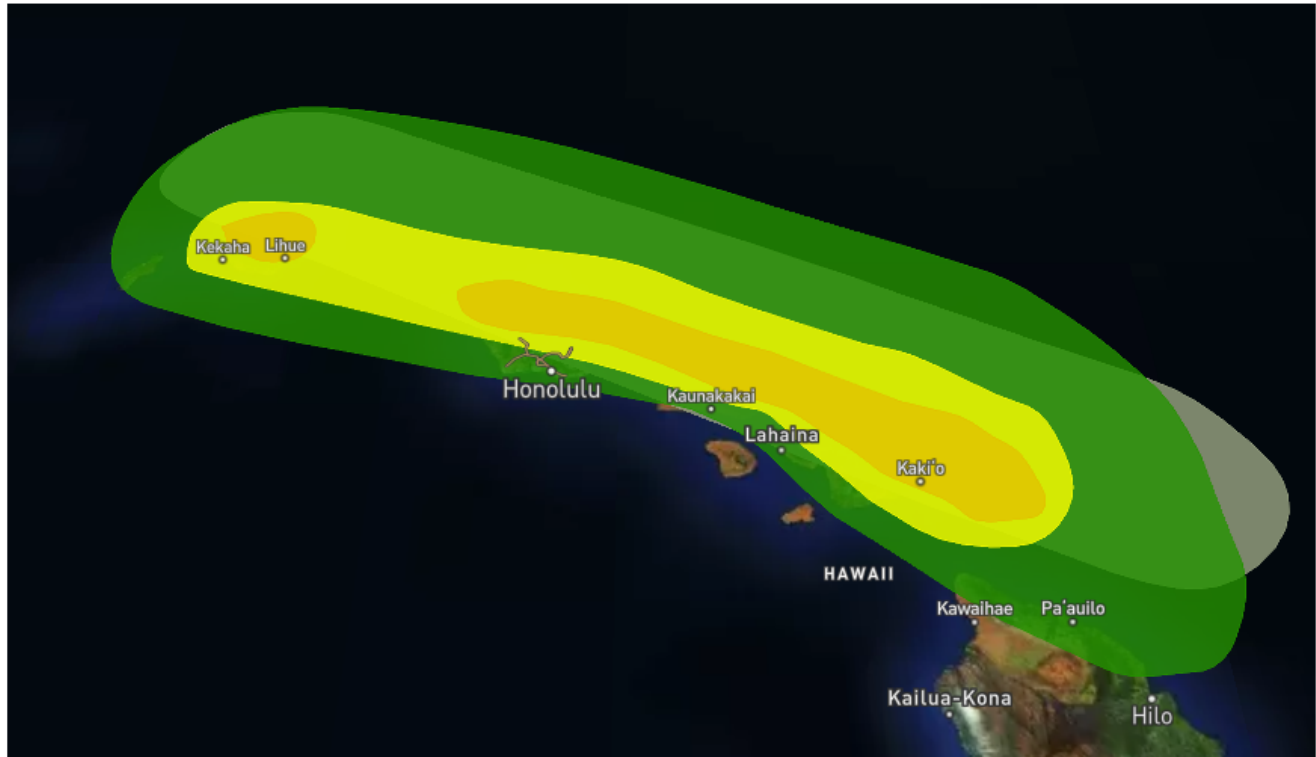


Threat Reports

Changes From Previous Forecast

The start time was delayed slightly and the end time was extended slightly. The southern periphery of the tropical cyclone risk area was trimmed slightly. The precipitation totals were also decreased.

Our Forecast

Douglas is still forecast to be a tropical storm by the time it impacts Maui, Molokai, Oahu, and Kauai from Sunday through Monday morning. Heavy rainfall is likely on the west facing slopes of the islands south of the center and the east facing slopes for areas east of the center. Rainfall totals of up to 4 to 6 inches will be possible in the slight impact area while rainfall totals of up to 6 inches will be possible in the moderate impact area. Locally heavier rainfall totals of up to 10 inches will also be possible, especially in any mountainous areas.

Tropical Storm force winds will also be possible in the slight tropical cyclone risk area. These winds will impact that respective area.

Main Impacts

Rainfall Impacts:

Flash flooding and mudslides will likely occur in areas that experience the heaviest rainfall. Some flood damage could occur and significant travel delays are expected.

Wind Impacts:

Scattered power outages will be possible.

Surge Impacts:

High waves could cause some damage to coastal structures.
